DVConnect operates a range of telephone helplines to assist Queenslanders escaping domestic and family violence, as well as support those who have experienced sexual assault.

WOMENSLINE 1800 811 811

24 hours, 7 days. We help anyone identifying as a women escape domestic violence. We help with developing a safety plan, emergency transport and accommodation, safe accommodation for pets, crisis counselling and intervention.

MENSLINE 1800 600 636

9am - midnight, 7 days. We help anyone identifying as a male escape domestic violence. We help develop a safety plan, emergency transport and accommodation and crisis counselling. We also offer support to men using violence to help them permanently change their behaviour.

SEXUAL ASSAULT HELPLINE 1800 010 120

7.30am - 11.30am, 7 days. We help anyone who has experienced sexual assault or abuse, or anyone concerned about someone they know. Our experienced counsellors explain options and provide support throughout the decision making process.

24 hours, 7 days. The National sexual assault and domestic and family violence counselling, information and referral service. It is confidential and is available via online chat and telephone.

PETS IN CRISIS
