- Safe accommodation for pets through our Pets In Crisis program

All people have the right to safe relationships. Mensline supports men experiencing abuse or using abuse in their intimate partner or family relationships.

Mensline is available 9am until midnight, 7 days a week.

We provide:

- Support for men impacted by domestic and family violence through safety planning, transport, information and referral
- Support for men to change their abusive behaviours.
